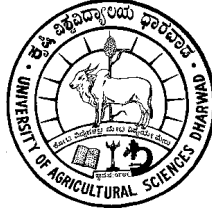

Introduction

In pursuit of modernizing agriculture and providing professional services to the farming community, the College of Agriculture, Dharwad, was established in 1947 by the erstwhile provincial state of Bombay. This college was started at Agricultural Research Station, Hebballi Farm (Dharwad) about 8 kms., away from present campus. Initially, the college was affiliated to Bombay University and in 1950 affiliation was transferred to Karnatak University, Dharwad. The College came under administrative control of the Department of Agriculture, Government of Mysore (later renamed as Karnataka) after re-organization of the state in 1956. Subsequently, the College became the constituent college of University of Agricultural Sciences, Bangalore in 1965 and with the formation of a separate agriculture University in Northern Karnataka in 1986, the college came under the jurisdiction of University of Agricultural Sciences, Dharwad. The University has multifold functions of teaching, research and extension in the field of agriculture and allied sciences. Presently, the University's jurisdiction extends to 7 northern districts of Karnataka. The University with its 4 constituent colleges, 21 Research Stations, 5 KVKs' and 6 EEU's caters to the needs of farming community and thereby plays an active role in enhancing the agricultural production.

Teaching

One of the missions of the University is to impart higher education in agriculture and allied sciences for creating and developing human resources in the fields necessary for overall agricultural development of the country, in general, and state, in particular. Teaching activity is carried out through four colleges in three campuses. All the colleges have been accredited by ICAR with "A" Grade. Both undergraduate (UG) and postgraduate (PG) programmes are offered in different disciplines under semester system. Undergraduate degree programmes are offered in the following colleges.

As the pattern of education is in semester system, the time taken to obtain the degree will ultimately depend upon the time taken by the student to complete the prescribed course credits.

Admission

Eligibility for Admission

Candidates to be eligible for admission to undergraduate degree programmes of the University should satisfy the following requirements.

A pass in two years PUC Science examination of the Karnataka Pre-University Board or an equivalent examination with the combination of Physics, Chemistry, Biology and with any one science subject.

OR

A pass in two years PUC Science examination of the Karnataka Pre-University Board with Inter-Agriculture subject.

- Note:**
- 1) In respect of Kashmiri Migrants seeking admission, the directions of Government of Karnataka will be followed.
 - 2) The candidates need not take CET examination conducted by the Government of Karnataka.
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DOMICILE REQUIREMENT

Candidate should be a citizen of India and must satisfy one of the following eligibility criteria/ conditions laid down under Clause A to M for admission to Under-graduate Degree programmes. The candidates who do not satisfy any of the Clauses / eligibility criteria / condition detailed below will not be eligible for admission. Each condition is specified as a Clause and is individually referred by a code . Candidates are required to furnish copies of the documents in support of their claim.

<p>In the case of candidates whose mother tongue is Kannada, Tulu or Kodava and who are residing outside the State of Karnataka but within the territory of India as on 1st July of admission year, such candidates should have passed the qualifying examination from an University or Board or any other recognized Institution located outside Karnataka. The candidate shall produce Kannada test result certificate conducted by CET during the current year on the day of counselling to establish his ability to speak read and write Kannada. <p>Son or daughter of serving defence personnel who at the time of joining the defence service had declared his/ her hometown a place in the State of Karnataka. Proof of such domicile should be obtained and produced by obtaining the extract from the Record Office of the Defence unit. Further, the candidates should have passed the qualifying examination from University and Board or any other institution located anywhere in India.</p>	F

<p>In the case of a candidate who is a son or daughter of a defence personnel who had served in Karnataka for atleast one year and is posted on duty directly to the disturbed areas of Jammu and Kashmir or North-East and whose family is permitted by Defence Authorities to continue to stay in Kamataka. Such candidate should have studied and passed the qualifying examination from any Government or government recognised educational institution located in Kamataka.</p>	G
<p>Son or daughter of an ex-servicemen who at the time of joining the defence service had declared a place in Karnataka as his home town, proof of such domicile should be obtained and produced from the “Deputy Director. Department of Sainik Welfare and Resettlement”. NOTE. The candidates who come under clause A to L are required to furnish copies of all the following relevant documents in support of their claim as detailed below.

Clause - A SSLC Marks Card, 2nd PUC Marks Card, Candidate's Study Certificate and Rural Study Certificate, Kannada Medium Study Certificate, Caste / Caste Income Certificate, if applicable

Clause - B SSLC Marks Card, 2nd PUC Marks Card, Candidate's Study Certificate and Caste / Caste Income Certificate, if applicable, along with

- 1) A certificate for either of the parent having studied for at least 7 years in Karnataka from the Head of the educational institution where he/she had studied. (Parent's Study Certificate).
- 2) The candidate's study certificate for having studied 1st and II PUC or equivalent examination in Karnataka issued by the head of the education institution. (Candidate's Study Certificate).

Clause- C SSLC Marks Card & 2nd PUC Marks Card, along with

- 1) A domicile certificate issued by the concerned Revenue or Municipal Authorities certifying that the candidate has resided outside the state of Karnataka but within the territory of India. The issuing authority should correspond to the place of domicile of the candidate.
- 2) A domicile certificate issued by concerned Revenue Authorities of the state of Karnataka regarding the previous domicile of the parents in the state of Karnataka. The place of the issuing authority should correspond to the place of domicile of the parent.
- 3) Either of the parents 10th std. Marks card, original cumulative record, candidate's Transfer Certificate or any other documentary proof in original in support of mother tongue and the Parent's Study Certificate for having studied 7 years in Karnataka.
- 4) A duly sworn declaration regarding mother tongue of the candidates (Please see APPENDIX - II for the prescribed format)

The photocopies of all the above documents pertaining to this clause should be enclosed compulsorily along with the application
(Horanaadu Kannadiga).

Clause - D SSLC Marks Card & 2nd PUC Marks Card, along with

- 1) a present residential certificate from the concerned Tahsildar of the respective taluk.

- 2) Either of the parents 10th std. Marks card, original cumulative record or any other documentary proof in original in support of mother tongue and Parent's Study Certificate for having studied 7 years in Karnataka.
- 3) A duly sworn declaration regarding mother tongue of the candidates (Please see APPENDIX -II for the prescribed format)

The photocopies of all the above documents pertaining to this clause should be enclosed compulsorily along with the application
(Gadinaadu Kannadiga)

Clause - E SSLC Marks Card & 2nd PUC Marks Card, along with

- 1) the certificate for having studied II PUC or equivalent examination in Karnataka issued by the head of the educational institution. (Candidate's Study Certificate)
- 2) employment certificate of the parent issued by the controlling office where the parent is working indicating the period during which he has worked in Karnataka.

Clause - F SSLC Marks Card, 2nd PUC Marks Card, Candidate's Study Certificate and Caste / Caste Income Certificate, if applicable, along with parent's home town declaration certificate while joining the service issued by record office of the defence unit.

Clause - G SSLC Marks Card and 2nd PUC Marks Card, along with

- 1) the certificate for having studied II PUC or equivalent examination in Karnataka issued by the head of the educational institution (Candidate's Study Certificate)
- 2) service certificate of the parent issued by the controlling officer indicating the period during which the parent has worked in Karnataka and a certificate showing the present place of posting, indicating that his family is permitted to stay in Karnataka.

Clause - H SSLC Marks Card, 2nd PUC Marks Card, Candidate's Study Certificate and Caste / Income Certificate, if applicable, along with parent's home town declaration certificate while joining the service issued by Joint Director / Deputy Director, Department of Sainik Welfare and Resettlement.

Clause - I SSLC Marks Card & 2nd PUC Marks Card, along with

- 1) the certificate for having studied II PUC or equivalent examination in Karnataka Issued by the head of the educational institution. (Candidate's Study Certificate)

- 2) a certificate from the employer indicating the parent's period of employment in Karnataka and also showing that he is transferable anywhere in India.

Clause - J SSLC Marks Card, 2nd PUC Marks Card, Candidate's Study Certificate and Caste / Caste Income Certificate, if applicable, along with

- 1) a certificate of the parent employee for having studied for at least 7 years Karnataka between 1st Std. and 12th Std. From the Head of the educational institution (Parent's Study Certificate)
- 2) home town declaration certificate of the parent employee while joining the service, showing that he is transferable anywhere in India issued by the employee.

Clause - K SSLC Marks Card, 2nd PUC Marks Card, Candidate's Study Certificate and Caste / Caste Income Certificate, if applicable, along with a certificate showing that the parent is / was a Member of Parliament elected from Karnataka issued by the Parliament Secretariat.

Clause - L SSLC Marks card, 2nd PUC Marks card, candidates study certificate, caste / caste income certificate, parents certificate regarding service belonging to All India Service of Karnataka cadre and of the Karnataka State Government.

Clause - M SSLC Marks card, 2nd PUC Marks card alongwith a certificate (IDENTITY CARD) issued by the jurisdictional "District Magistrate and Deputy Commissioner" of any state in India, as the proof of migration.

- Note:*
1. *Wherever the eligibility of the candidate is, based on the study, employment, etc., of the parent, documents to establish the relationship of the candidate with the parent has to be produced.*
 2. *The contents of the documents submitted by the candidates should be either in Kannada or English language, if the documents are in any other official languages the same should be got translated to Kannada or English language. Other wise the UASD reserves the right to reject the same.*
 3. *In case, if any of the documents produced in respect of the Clause/s claimed by the candidate is found to be false/incorrect, the seat selected by the candidate will be cancelled at any stage and the entire fee amount paid by such candidate will be forfeited. Necessary criminal proceedings will be initiated.*

RESERVATION OF SEATS

Admission to the University is made subject to reservation of seats for:

- (1) **Agriculturists or children of Agriculturists as defined in the Act of UAS 1963, Dharwad (23.8%).** “Agriculturist” for this purpose means a person who, as owner or tenant, holds land and whose main source of income is from personal cultivation of the land and including any person whose principal means of livelihood is from manual labour in Agricultural land, the seats of which will be filled through Practical Test conducted by the University.
- (2) **The remaining seats (76.2%) are treated as General seats.** For both Agriculturist and general quota vertical reservation is given as per the existing reservation policy of Government of Karnataka i.e. reservation shall be made in favour of candidates belonging to **Schedule caste, Schedule tribes and other Backward Communities (OBC) as notified by the Government of Karnataka under categories: Category-1, 2A, 2B 3A, 3B in accordance with the Government order No. SWL 251 BCA 94 Bangalore dated 31-1-1995 and as amended from time to time, the seats of which will be filled through General Counseling in the University.**

For each of the vertical category under item (1) & (2) mentioned above the following reservations are made horizontally in favour of the following categories.

- (a) **Rural (15%):** The eligibility criteria shall be as defined in Karnataka Reservation of Appointments or Posts in the Civil Services of the state for Rural Candidates Act, 2000 (Karnataka Act-1 of 2001) and as amended from time to time.
- (b) **Kannada Medium Study (5%):** Candidates who have studied in Kannada Medium in accordance with Government Order No. ED 91 URC 2002 Bangalore dated 31-7-2002 and as amended from time to time.
- (3) **Special Categories (Total 12%):** Provision is made under horizontal reservation of seats to the following special categories.
 - a) **NCC :** Candidates
 - i) who have participated in Republic Day Camp conducted by the Directorate General of NCC, New Delhi from Karnataka and who possess at least ‘B’ Certificate under NCC obtained during the five years period of studying in Karnataka between 8th to 12th standards: or
 - ii) who have participated in the following camps conducted by the Directorate General of NCC, New Delhi from Karnataka and who possess at least ‘B’ Certificate under NCC obtained during the five years period of study in Karnataka between 8th to 12th standards namely:-

All India Thal Sainik Camp (Boys)	:	TSC (B)
All India Thal Sainik Camp (Girls)	:	TSC(G)
All India Nau Sainik Camp	:	NSC
All India Vayu Sainik Cam	:	VSC and youth exchange programmes and foreign naval crews organised by DG NCC.

iii) who have participated in the following camps conducted by the Directorate General of NCC, New Delhi from Karnataka who possess at least 'B' Certificate under NCC obtained during the five-years period of study in Karnataka between 8th to 12th standards.

a) All India Thal Sainik Camp (Boys) - TSC (B); All India Thal Sainik Camp (Girls) - TSC (G); c) All India Nau Sainik Camp - NSC; d) All India Vayu Sainik Camp - VSC AND in the complete - Mountaineering Expeditions (over 5900 mtrs.), Sailing Expeditions using wind power only (401 kms), Moto Cycle Expeditions (more than 3500 Kms) and Cycling Expeditions (more than 1500 Kms), organised by DG, NCC / NCC Directorate of Karnataka & Goa.

iv) who have participated in the following camps / courses conducted by the Directorate General of NCC, New Delhi from Karnataka and who possess at least 'B' Certificate obtained during the five year period of study in Karnataka between 8th and 12th standards namely : a) NIC; b) Trekking; c) Mountaineering; d) BLC ; e) ALC; f) RCTC and g) Army, Navy, Air Force & Hospital Attachments.

v) who possess at least 'B certificate obtained during the five year period of study in Karnataka between 8th and 12th standards.

Provided that for selection of a reserved seat under NCC category, the preferential criteria are as follows:

Preference 1 : Candidate possessing 'B' Certificate and adjudged overall All India Best Cadet with Gold / Silver / Bronze medal in the Republic Day Camp.

Preference 2 : 'B' certificate holders who have won Gold / Silver / Bronze medal in the camps mentioned at (a) to (d) of sub-clause (ii) above

Preference 3 : 'B' certificate holders who have participated in the **Youth Exchange Programmes and Foreign Naval Cruise** organised by DG, NCC

Preference 4 : 'B' certificate holders who have participated from Karnataka in the Republic Day camp.

Preference 5 : 'B' certificate holders who have participated from Karnataka in the camps mentioned at (a) to (d) of sub-clause (iii) above

Preference 6 : 'B' certificate holders who have participated in the **Mountaineering / Sailing / Motor Cycle / Cycling Expeditions** organised by DG, NCC / NCC Directorate of Karnataka & Goa.

Preference 7 : 'B' certificate holders who have participated in the camps mentioned in sub-clause iv) above.

Preference 8 : Candidates possessing only 'B' certificate

Provided that for selection of a reserved seat under NCC category, candidates possessing 'B' Certificate and adjudged BEST CADET in Republic Day camp shall be considered first; 'B' certificate holders and who have won individual medal in the competitions counting towards Republic Day Banner in the Republic Day camp shall be considered second; 'B' certificate holders who have participated in the Republic Day camp shall be considered third; 'B' certificate holders who have won individual medal in the competitions counting towards R.D. Banner in the camps mentioned in sub-clauses (ii) shall be considered fourth and the 'B' certificate holders who have participated in the camp mentioned in sub-clauses (ii) shall be considered next before considering the candidates referred to in sub-clause (iii);

Provided further that the candidates belonging to sub-clause (ii) i.e. only 'B' certificate holders shall be eligible to select the NCC special category seats, if any, in the general round of seat selection along with the other General Merit and Reserved category candidates as per their merit order.

b) Sports : Candidates

- (i) who have represented country and won medals / cups in the **SUPER A-Games** specified in **SCHEDULE - 1** during the five years period of study in Karnataka between 8th and 12th standards;
 - (ii) who have represented the country and won medals/cups in **A-games** specified in **SCHEDULE-I** during the five-years period of study in Karnataka between 8th and 12th standards;
 - (iii) who have won medals / cups in **B-Games** specified in **SCHEDULE-1** by representing Karnataka State and participated in the **SUPER A-Games or A-Games** specified in **SCHEDULE-1** during the five-years period of study in Karnataka between 8th and 12th standards;
 - (iv) who have represented Karnataka State in **B-games** specified in **SCHEDULE-I** and won medals/cups during the five years period of the study in Karnataka between 8th and 12th standards;
 - (v) who have represented Karnataka State in any sports or games in the **B-Games** specified in **SCHEDULE-I** during the five years period of study in Karnataka between 8th and 12th standards.
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Provided that for selection of a reserved seat in Sports category, the candidates who belong to sub-clause(i) shall be considered first; candidates who belong to sub-clause (ii) shall be considered second; candidates who belong to sub-clause (iii) shall be considered third and candidates who belong to sub-clause(iv) shall be considered fourth before considering the candidates belonging to sub-clause (v).

Provided further that, while considering the candidates mentioned in sub-clauses and (v), gold medal winners will be preferred to Silver medallist who inturn will be preferred to Bronze medallist under the respective sub-clauses, irrespective of the number of medals.

Provided, also that the candidates belonging to sub-clause(v), i.e., only who have represented the Karnataka State, shall be eligible to select the sports seats during counseling-cum-admission.

c) Scouts and Guides:

Candidates who as Scouts / Guides have received the “President award” during 5 years period of study in Kamataka between 8th to 12th standards. Provided that the candidates shall enclose a xerox copy of the President’s Award Certificate along with the application.

d) Children of Defence Personnel

Subject to the conditions laid down under Clause E, F & G of domicile requirement, **Defence Personnel** means a person in Defence Service including Personnel belonging to Civil GT COYS ASC who were Civilian Class III or class ‘IV’ Government servants “and Border Roads Organizational Personnel”. (Vide Notification No. ED 189 TGL 94 Bangalore dated 29-7-1994 and as amended from time to time).

e) Children of Ex-servicemen

Subject to the conditions laid down under Clause H of domicile requirement, **Ex-servicemen** for the purpose of this clause includes personnel belonging to Civil GT COYS, ASC who were Civilian Class III or Class IV Government Servants, who became permanently disabled or were killed during hostilities.

f) Candidates with Physical Disability

Candidates have to produce a certificate of Physical disability from a Government Medical Officer only not below the rank of District Surgeon, to the extent that the candidate does not have less than 40% and more than 75% of the physical disability

g) Candidates from Anglo-Indian community

Candidates have to enclose a copy of the certificate issued by the **Registered Association of Anglo-Indian Community in the State of Karnataka**.

- Note: 1.** The following candidates are not eligible for claiming reservation of seats under **2A, 2B, 3A & 3B** as per the G.O. NO.SWD 225 BCA 2000 dated 30th March, 2002 and amendments thereon from time to time (New comprehensive creamy layer policy).
- i) Son(s)/Daughter(s) of the persons specified in the said Govt. Order under item-1.
 - ii) The candidates and either of whose parents/guardian is a Group-A or Group - B officer in the services of the Government or holds an equivalent post in public sector undertakings or an employee of a private industry/institution and draws a salary which is not less than that of a Group-B officer (pay scale of Rs.6,000 - 11,200).
 - iii) The candidate and his/her father's, Mother's / guardian's gross annual income exceeds Rs.2.00 lakhs.
 - iv) The candidate and his/her father's / mother's / guardians holding 10 units of Agricultural Land as specified in the Karnataka Land Reforms Act 1961 and such of those holding more than 20 acres of plantation land.
- 2) Candidates claiming reservations under **SC/ST & other Backward communities (Category-1, 2A, 2B, 3A, 3B)** shall have to produce the valid certificate by the appropriate authorities.
 - 3) Candidates claiming reservation under **Special Categories** i.e., NCC/Sports /Scouts & Guides/Defence/Ex-Servicemen/Anglo-Indians/Physically Disability shall produce valid documents, which is **subject to scrutiny / verification and confirmation** by the relevant authorities. However, the selection for Physically Handicapped category is subject to the condition that **candidates with less than 40% and more than 75% of the physical disability.**
 - 4) Candidates claiming reservation under **Rural Category** are governed by the G.O.No.ED 01 **TEC** 2002 Bangalore dated 01 -02-2002 of Government of Karnataka and as amended from time to time. They are required to produce study certificates from 1st to 10th standard as in the format furnished in the prospectus, certified by the concerned authorities duly affixing the signature, seal & date in the application format itself.. The list of places which do not come under preview of rural area is also enclosed for ready reference (Schedule-II).
 - 5) Candidates claiming reservation for studying in **Kannada Medium** are required to produce certificates from 1st to 10th standard as in the format furnished in the prospectus, certified by the concerned authorities duly affixing the signature, seal & date.
 - 6) Candidates claiming reservation under **Agriculturist quota** i.e., Agriculturist or children of Agriculturist including Agricultural labourer, should furnish the
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Certificate III (format furnished in prospectus) duly certified by the Revenue Tahsildar of the area affixing the signature, seal & date in the **application format itself**. In case of candidates whose parents draw salary, they are required to produce a Salary Certificate (format furnished in prospectus). In case of candidates whose parents have income from sources other than Agriculture and salary are required to produce an Affidavit (format furnished in prospectus).

- 7) If any seats reserved in favour of candidates under vertical reservation referred above are not filled up due to non-availability of eligible candidates, **such vacant seats shall stand transferred to the General Merit**. Similarly if any seats reserved in favour of candidates belonging to special category (horizontal reservation) referred to above fall vacant due to non availability of eligible candidate belonging to such categories of vertical reservation **shall stand transferred to their respective categories specified**.
- 8) **Candidates from states other than Karnataka are not eligible to seek admission directly for all Under-graduate degree Programmes in the University**. However, they can apply to the Indian Council of Agricultural Research, New Delhi. They will have to submit a separate application as and when called by ICAR, New Delhi and take All India Competitive Examinations and attend Counselling at New Delhi for seat allotment, For details the candidates may contact; **The Assistant Director General (Edn.), Indian Council of Agricultural Research, Krishi Anusandhana Bhavan, Pusa, New Delhi-110 012**.

(4) Foreign Nationals and Non Resident Indians (NRIs)/Children of NRIs:

There is also a provision for admitting **15 per cent to Agriculture and allied courses** over and above the prescribed intake, to the **eligible Foreign Nationals/ NRIs /Children of NRIs** irrespective of the place where they had their previous education under the special quota. They should apply directly to the Registrar, Yattinagudda campus, Krishinagar, UAS, Dharwad-580 005, Karnataka, India along with the Educational certificate, Proof of Status of NRI and other relevant documents.

Candidates belonging to Foreign Nationals shall send their application through Indian Council of Agricultural Research or Agencies / Consultants nominated by ICAR/GOI, New Delhi through their Embassies. The NRIs/ children of NRI's should send their application along with their Bio-data and proof of their NRI status to the Registrar, Krishinagar UAS, Dharwad-580 005 for verification and confirmation as per regulations.

(5) Kashmiri Migrants

Provision is also made to admit one candidate for each degree programme to the eligible **Kashmiri migrants** as per the G.O. NO. AHD 63 AUM 03, Bangalore dated 10-7-2003 as approved and amended by UAS(D) from time to time. The candidates should apply to the Registrar, Krishinagar UAS, Dharwad-580 005 on plain paper affixing their passport size photographs with the following details; (i) Name of the Candidate (ii) Father's name (iii) Mother's name, (iv) Nationality, (v) Sex, (vi) Date of Birth, (vii) Individual marks of Physics, Chemistry, Biology obtained in II PUC/12th Standard with maximum marks (viii) Full postal address and PIN code, (ix) Telephone No. with STD code. The applicants should enclose copies of 10th Standard Marks card, 12th Standard Marks card and **IDENTITY CARD issued by the jurisdictional Deputy Commissioner and District Magistrate of Government of Karnataka in support of their status as Kashmiri migrants.**

MODE OF ADMISSION

The admission to various undergraduate degree programmes shall be made based on the Per cent marks in PCB in second year PUC Science for all degrees.

The admission of candidates is subject to the following conditions:

- a) Verification of original marks card and other details furnished in the application
 - b) Seats being vacant
 - c) Payment of prescribed fees to the University on or before the notified dates for such purpose.
 - d) Registration of courses before the last date
 - e) Production of Transfer Certificate from the previous College/Institution.
-

Admission for the reserved seats excluding those set apart for agriculturists or children / a ward of agriculturists and ICAR nominees shall be made strictly according to the merit of candidates eligible for the reserved seats, subject to the same condition mentioned above. If there are any reserved seats unfilled, such seats shall be deemed to have been transferred to the general pool and filled up as indicated above.

For the seats reserved for Agriculturists or Children/ward of Agriculturists, mode of admission shall be as under:

The merit list will be prepared based on 50% marks secured in PCB in second year PUC science and 50% marks secured in the Practical Test. The Practical Test shall be conducted for 200 marks in the University on the specified date. The candidates who fail to appear for PT are considered as not eligible. Those candidates who attend the Practical Test and **score less than 100 marks in PT are also considered as not eligible** for claiming seats under this quota.

The seats will be allotted based on the merit and roster as prescribed by the Govt. of Karnataka from time to time.

Counselling-cum-Admission

The counselling will be held at UAS, Dharwad campus. From out of the merit list prepared by the Admission Committee constituted by the Vice-Chancellor, the committee will invite for counselling a number of candidates under each category of reservation or general as the case may be, larger than the actual number required under each category in the same order or merit, to verify if the candidate possesses good moral habits and is physically fit, eligibility of Horanadu/Gadinadu Kannadigas as also to verify the facts furnished in the application form, without assigning any marks. From out of those who actually attended the counselling and found eligible, the committee may recommend for admission the actual number of candidates required under each category and to be kept in reserve in the same order of merit as their names appear in the main list under each category.

- Note:** 1) The fee concession is provided to SC/ST/Cat-I candidates as per Govt. order provided they produce Caste Income Verified Certificate from the competent authorities, failing which they have to remit the full fees.
- 2) Registration fees shall not be refunded once the student has registered for a course in the University. Tuition and other course fees paid by the student admitted to various degree programmes of the University shall not be refunded except when students registering for a semester are forced to drop out from the semester by the University for any reasons other than on disciplinary grounds.
- 3) The students who have been admitted from one degree programme to another and one college to another are exempted from payment of Tuition fees, Caution money deposit and N.C.C deposit provided they have paid fees in the first admission during the same academic year.
- 4) All the students who are admitted to the degree programme should pay the prescribed fees (Non refundable) on the spot and on the day of admission.

REGISTRATION

Admission is incomplete without registration of required courses relevant to the degree programme. Hence all the students admitted to different degree programmes should go through the process of REGISTRATION IN PERSON. Failure to register for courses in the first semester on or before the notified date results in forfeiture of admission.

Registration for the first time in the University

The students who receive admission notice from the University to various degree programmes, shall pay other fees on or before the last date specified in the admission notice and report for registration on the first day of the semester at the respective colleges.

Orientation programme shall be conducted by the Dean concerned for the benefit of the newly admitted students.

The registration of students admitted from waiting list shall cease after four weeks of commencement of the first semester. Attendance in respect of fresh students shall be reckoned from the date of his/her registration.

The candidates admitted to undergraduate programme shall not be permitted to drop the first semester. The admission of such candidates shall stand automatically cancelled.

Students who register for the first semester should complete at least one course satisfactorily earning a grade other than SA (Shortage of Attendance)/US (Unsatisfactory) or F (Fail) failing which the admission shall be cancelled.

SCHOLARSHIPS AND FREE STUDENTSHIP

The University awards Merit Scholarships and General Scholarships based on the merit to the students of all the colleges as per regulation and also Free-Studentships as per the Government orders.

Students Aid Fund

An amount of Rs.100-00 per student per year is collected towards the Student Aid fund and is awarded as per the regulations.

Hostels

Hostel accommodation will be provided to the extent available on the campus.

Application in the prescribed form for admission to the hostel by the students admitted to colleges should be submitted to the Hostel Warden well in advance of the commencement of the academic year. The application forms can be had from the office of the Hostel Warden on payment of Rs.50-00 in cash or by sending the amount by crossed Indian Postal Order endorsed to the Warden of the respective college Hostels together with a self-addressed and stamped cover.

In addition to the above fees, the boarder shall pay a room rent of Rs.40/-, Rs.60/- as maintenance and Rs.70/- establishment charges per month. He shall also pay the mess, electricity and establishment charges, etc., as per hostel regulations.

Medical Examination

Every student admitted to the college shall be required to undergo medical Examination once every year in accordance with the direction issued by the University. Medical facility for simple ailments is available in the campus.

General

The students admitted to the University shall abide by the Rules and Regulations prescribed by the University from time to time. Separate rules in respect of student discipline in classrooms, hostel and campuses etc. are available in the University Academic Information & Regulation Booklet.

All the students shall give an undertaking that he/she shall abide by the rules and regulations of the University as amended from time to time.
