In pursuance of the above and in accordance with the ICAR guidelines, the general requirements / qualifications for appointment to the posts of teachers in the cadre of Professor, Associate Professor and Assistant Professor in UAS, Dharwad, are prescribed as enclosed in the **Annexure**.

The said qualifications shall come into effect from the date of this notification.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS / QUALIFICATIONS PRESCRIBED FOR APPOINTMENT TO THE POSTS OF TEACHERS IN UAS, DHARWAD.

I. PROFESSOR CADRE:

1. A Ph.D. Degree in the concerned subject.
2. An eminent scholar with published work of high quality, actively engaged in Teaching, and/or experience in Research/Extension at University/National level Institutions, including experience of guiding research at PG level with 10 years of experience (excluding period spent for obtaining Ph.D. Degree subject to a maximum of 3 years) provided 5 years experience shall be in Associate Professor cadre (Pay scale of Rs.12000-18300 or as revised from time to time) or its equivalent position in the concerned subject.

Note: Detailed qualifications for concerned subjects are prescribed separately for each discipline. Irrespective of whether a candidate has completed Ph.D on deputation / study leave / sandwich programme/external candidate etc.

II. ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR CADRE:

1. A Ph.D. Degree in the concerned subject.
2. Good academic record, in addition to these, candidates who join from outside University system, shall also possess at least 55% of the marks or an equivalent grade of B in the seven point scale with letter grades O,A, B, C, D, and E & F at the Master 's degree level.
3. Five (5) years of experience in Teaching and/or Research/Extension in cadre of Assistant Professor (pay scale of Rs.8000-13500 or as revised time to time) or its equivalent position in the concerned subject, excluding the period spent for obtaining the Ph.D. Degree (subject to a maximum of 3 years) and has made some marks in the area of Scholarship as evidenced by quality of publication, contribution to educational innovation, design of new courses and curricula.

Note: Detailed qualifications for concerned subjects are prescribed separately for each discipline. Irrespective of whether a candidate has completed Ph.D on deputation / study leave / sandwich programme/external candidate etc.

III. ASSISTANT PROFESSOR CADRE:

1. Good Academic record with at least 55% of the marks or, an equivalent grade of B in 7 point scale with letter grades O, A, B, C, D, E & F at the Master's degree level, in the concerned subject from a recognized Indian University, or an equivalent degree from a Foreign University.
2. Candidates should have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) in the concerned / related subject for Assistant Professor post conducted by the ASRB/UGC/CSIR or a similar test accredited by the ICAR/ICMR/NCERT/UGC/CSIR i.e.,
 - a) For Agriculture/Animal Husbandry/Veterinary/Fisheries disciplines, ASRB/ ICAR NET in the concerned subject is prescribed.
 - b) For Humanities, languages, etc., UGC NET is prescribed.

c) For pure Sciences CSIR NET is prescribed

Note:

1. In exceptional cases where ASRB (ICAR) is not conducting the NET in certain disciplines, the candidates should pass NET in the disciplines approved by the Academic Council.
2. Related subject as decided by the Academic Council.
3. Detailed qualifications for concerned subjects are prescribed separately for each discipline.
4. A relaxation of 5% may be provided from 55% to 50% of the marks at the Master's level for the SC/ST category.
5. The details of conversion on 7 point scale into percentage equivalent is as under:

Seven Point Scale

| Grade | Grade point | Percentage equivalent |
|---------------------|-------------|-----------------------|
| 'O' = Outstanding | 5.50-6.00 | 75-100 |
| 'A' = Very Good | 4.50-5.49 | 65-74 |
| 'B' = Good | 3.50-4.49 | 55-64 |
| 'C' = Average | 2.50-3.49 | 45-54 |
| 'D' = Below Average | 1.50-2.49 | 35-44 |
| 'E' = Poor | 0.50-1.40 | 25-34 |
| 'F' = Fail | 0.00-0.49 | 00-25 |
